### **STREET REPORT:**

Darryl Main presented the letter that will be sent to the residents. All Council members reviewed the letter and agreed to send this information to our residents. This letter will also be sent to the York County Commissioners.

We did receive the contract from Barry Isett. It will be forwarded to the solicitor to review.

Darryl Main reported that when they came through with the railroad updated lights, they cut brush and threw it down in the creek. Darryl Main stated that he took and sent pictures to the PC and Penn Dot since they funded the project. Darryl Main stated they will clean this up before they come for the final inspection.
