

THE MOUNT WOLF BOROUGH NON-VOTING MEETING

JULY 23, 2024

The Mount Wolf Council held a non-voting meeting on Tuesday July 23, 2024. The meeting was called to order by President Darryl Main at 7:00 pm with a work session and the meeting began at 8:00 pm.

MAYOR'S REPORT:

Mayor Starner reported that she got the letters written to send to residents. Council members thanked Mayor Starner for writing the letters to our residents regarding trash and street paving. Mayor Starner reported that she had a complaint about a neighbor parking their boat and trailer and basketball pole/hoop on the street. Darryl Main stated that the basketball pole/hoop needs to be moved at the end of each day. It can not sit on the streets. Mayor Starner stated that the Ordinance reads as:

Except in an emergency or for loading or unloading, no person shall park a trailer, semitrailer or combination, on any street in such a manner that any part of the vehicle or vehicles shall:

Extend into the main-traveled portion of the street.

Interfere with visibility of traffic at an intersection; or

Abut the property of any person without such person's permission.

"Trailer" is defined as every vehicle without motive power designed to carry property or passengers wholly on its own structure and to be drawn by a motor vehicle.

Mayor Starner reported that they can park the trailer as long as they follow the Ordinance. Darryl Main stated the Borough Council may need to revise and update the Ordinance.

STREET REPORT:

Dennis Naylor reported that the backhoe has been repaired. They replaced the radiator. Dennis Naylor reported that the maintenance crew will start painting the street with crossing lines before school starts. Darryl Main reported that the radar speed signs should be installed within the next 2-3 weeks.

PARKS AND RECREATION REPORT:

PROPERTY AND SERVICE REPORT:

Brian McKenna reported that he spoke with Todd Hess, and he stated that Todd Hess reported that he will start painting the Borough building August 10th, 2024. Pat Poet reported that her granddaughter probably will not be able to paint the mural until next summer due to the delay in painting the Borough building. All Council members were fine with waiting until next summer.

BUDGET AND FINANCE REPORT:

Michael Barlett reported that finance meetings will need to be scheduled. Our first session will be held in August. Darryl Main reported that the budget needs to be approved by November, so the funds for Eagle Fire Company can be released to the Eagle Fire Company in December.

Pat Poet reported that Northeastern Sewer Authority should have a list of all rental properties in the Borough. Darryl Main asked the Council members if they could donate their time getting a list together so Barry Isett and Company can complete the inspections that are required.

OLD BUSINESS:

Pat Poet reported that she has a complaint about the car dealer parking his cars that are for sale on the street. Pat Poet reported that it does not look professional. Josh Parish reported that the borough can not enforce anything with parking and the property lines. Josh Parish stated that this is a civil matter.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mayor Starner reported that National Night Out will be held on August 6th from 5pm to 8pm. Darry Main suggested that the Council Members should attend this event.
