## **PUBLIC COMMENTS:**

Jason Miles is the Vice President for NEYSA. Jason requested permission to use both parks, Mt. Wolf and Greiman, for the practice of football and cheerleading. They are requesting to use those fields from July 31, 2023 until November, unless they go to states and then December. They used Shelly Park in Newberry Township in prior years, but the Township did not renew their contract. It will be approximately 70 children. Jason stated the space is needed for 3 football teams and 5 cheerleading squads. The fields would be used Monday ~ Thursday from 6pm until dusk. Ages of teams would be 7-13 year olds. The fields will be used for practice only. Jason stated that only "practice dummies" would be brought onto the fields. Darryl informed Jason if any equipment is left on the field and damage is done to it, we will not be held responsible for the damage. Mayor Starner also informed Jason that anything inside of the fence at the Mt. Wolf Baseball field is "off limits" to all children, coaches and parents. Darryl asked Jason to contact Dan and give him a scheduled of when the fields are requested. Darryl informed Jason that this will need to be voted on at our next Council meeting.

Darryl, Dennis, Mayor Starner and Todd left the meeting at 7:20pm to conduct an interview for the treasurer position. At this time Darryl appointed Michael to run the meeting until they return. Darryl, Dennis, Mayor Starner and Todd returned to the meeting at 7:40pm.

**MAYOR'S REPORT:**

Mayor Maureen Starner reported she had 2 resident complaints. She will address the complaints and send out violations letters. She reported that 1 resident still has the POD in front of her residence and she will be contacting her to have it removed. Mayor Starner attended the York County Police Commission meeting. There was discussion with Spring Garden Township as a new member. The Commission is looking into an addition to the York Township Building.

Sidewalk inspections will need to be completed. This will be scheduled for the fall. Each member of the Council offered to take a street(s) and report back to Mayor Starner. She will then send out the violation letters to the residents. They are continuing to paint new lines on the streets.
