### **PUBLIC COMMENTS:**

Desiree Boorujy (Northeastern Sewer Authority) asked if the Borough would be in favor of delaying the paving project until the Sewer Authority are finished with their project. Desiree stated should be completed by 2025. Desiree understands that the Borough has an agreement with Columbia Gas to have our streets paved by July.
