The Mount Wolf Council conducted a non-voting meeting on Tuesday May 27, 2025. The meeting was called to order by President Darryl Main at 7pm.

VISITORS:

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Jeff Clifton reported that Northeastern School District has been audited and completed by the State Police and stated that they are requesting a fence around the playground for the safety of the school-aged children and making it handicapped accessible. Jeff Clifton stated that the school district may be able to help with funding for the cost and placement of the fence around Mount Wolf Park.

Jamie Pratt stated that they have used a company in the past that has done excavation work for the Northeastern School District.

Darryl Main stated that the Council does not have any problems with placing a barrier fence. Darryl Main stated that the Council would need a quote before any decisions are set in stone.

Jeff Clifton Council of Northeastern School District could add lines in the parking lot for hopscotch and other games.

Pat Poet asked when the Park becomes handicapped accessible, would a path be put down through the park? Darryl Main stated that yes, a path will be placed.
