

MOUNT WOLF BOROUGH NON-VOTING MEETING

MAY 28, 2024

The Mount Wolf Council held a non-voting meeting on Tuesday May 28, 2024. The meeting was called to order by President Darryl Main @ 7:05pm.

MAYOR'S REPORT:

Mayor Starner stated that she had some resident complaints regarding the workers shutting off the water. Mayor Starner spoke with the supervisor at Kinsley. She informed him that the borough needs to be informed. He stated that will knock on the residents' doors and let them know that the water will be turned off, but they are not informing the residents that the water is turned back on.

Mayor Starner also reminded him that she needs to be informed when they are shutting roads. The supervisor at Kinsley asked the mayor to inform residents that the cars need to be moved by 7am. Mayor Starner asked for at least 48 hours notice so she can inform the residents regarding moving their cars. Mayor Starner will also inform Kinsley that they can not begin working before 7 am.

Norfolk Southern are digging on Maple Street. Chris Owens got a call from PA One today (5/28/24). The closest address is 17 Maple Street the purpose of the dig is for railroad crossing upgrade. They will need to locate all utilities. They will need 200 foot in all directions from intersection of the railroad tracks and Maple Street.

STREETS REPORT:

Bridge work is completed. Dennis stated that he looked at the bridge that was fixed. Dennis recommends that the Borough has Chris Owens look at the completed work before the bill is paid.

Dennis stated that the maintenance crew are painting the curbs in the Borough.

Dennis stated that there was an accident involving a tractor trailer and train. Dennis stated that the tractor trailer driver come to the railroad crossing and thought he could make it across before the train

would reach him. The road was closed for about 3 hours. Darryl stated that we will need to reach out to the police department to get a copy of the incident report.

PARKS AND RECREATION REPORT:

Dan got a letter from Manny (ACES) thanking the Borough for allowing the 12U to use Greiman fields. He also asked to use the Mount Wolf baseball field in the fall for 13U. Manny stated that they would be using the field for practices and games starting in the fall of 2024. Dan did check the schedule for the “Wolves and Bad Company”, and it looks like the field is not being used after Labor Day by “Bad Company and Wolves Baseball”.

He also offered to paint the basketball courts as a way to "give back to the community”.

PROPERTY AND SERVICE REPORT:

Richard Jackson fixed the fascia on the Borough building and Brian stated that an invoice was sent to Jennifer.

Todd Hess is working on getting Brian a quote to add a new base layer of paint to the Borough building. Brian stated that he spoke with Todd on the phone and Todd stated he should have a quote for Brian by the end of the week.

The maintenance crew still would like a “pully system”. Darryl stated to Keith he would have to re-evaluate the system before approving a “pully system”.

2-day garbage pick up has started and will continue until the end of July.
