MAYOR'S REPORT:

STREET REPORT:

Dennis Naylor reported that the streets in Mount Wolf Borough is still being worked on.

Mayor Starner reported that Inch and Company placed a turning lane at Emerson Flats. When Emerson Flats placed the turning lane they tarred and chipped the road leaving a horrible mess. Darryl Main reported that he contacted Shane at East Manchester Township and asked him if the street sweeper was available and Shane stated that it has been winterized. Shane did offer East Manchester Township's the power broom. Darryl Main stated that the power broom could not handle the clean up. East Manchester Township unwinterized the street sweeper and cleaned the streets for the borough. Darryl Main informed Shane from East Manchester Township to forward a bill to the borough for their services. A special "Thank you" to Shane and East Manchester Township for their assistance.

Dennis Naylor stated that leaf collection will begin on November 4th every Wednesday and Thursday thru December 13th weather permitting. Darryl Main stated that flyers will be placed throughout the Borough to inform residents.

Darryl Main reported that the state got our grant application for the backhoe, and it is under review.
